WHAT OUR SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Personal Care; includes personal hygiene, eating, communication, mobility and dressing.
- Skill reinforcement; includes implementing behavioral support plans and help with the use of communication and mobility devices.
- Training in self-determination; includes developing self-advocacy skills and acquiring skills that enable an individual to become more independent.
- Recreation and leisure; includes supports identified in the ISP that are therapeutic, and help to develop and maintain social relationships and family contacts.

Vocational Habilitation services teach and reinforce concepts related to work such as:

- Responsibility
- Attendance
- Problem Solving
- Social Interaction
- Motor Skill Development
- Safety

Operation of a 32,000 sq. ft. facility in which employees perform meaningful work and develop job skills through sub-contract work from local industry. Employees experience a variety of work opportunities, and are paid based upon productivity.

- **Supported Employment**

S&H staff work with BVR, private providers and the SSA Department to support an individual's opportunity for community employment. Once employed, S&H can provide "follow-along" supports to the individual and the employer to assist maintaining the placement.

- **Seniors**

Retirement program providing social interaction and community involvement. Individuals participate in leisure and recreational activities, exercise, music, crafts and games.

- **Adult Activities**

Services for individuals for whom work is not a primary goal. Focus in areas of self-help, sensory stimulation and integration, leisure, socialization and daily living skills.

- **Special Interest Activities**

Improved social skills, growth in self-direction and enhanced self-concept and improving employment readiness are addressed in these activities: Job Club, Project Stir (Self-advocacy), Friendship Club, Circles, People First, and Look Good Feel Good

- **Ancillary Services**

Full-time nursing services, physical therapy, mental health support in collaboration with Catholic Social Services and transportation.



Programs are available to eligible individuals in Shelby County with developmental disabilities who are at least 18 years of age.
